In 1972 the State Government vested the building known as the Freshwater Bay School at 66 Victoria Avenue with the Town of Claremont. Since 1975, the Museum has operated within the policies, procedures and documentation based on the Western Australian Museum's History Department system and museum standards nationally and internationally.

Claremont Museum has received awards for the best practice in all aspects of collection management, education programmes, special projects and acknowledgement by the Heritage Collection Committee of the Cultural Ministers Council as one of the top five local or regional museums in Australia.

The Museum provides a professionally maintained research facility, which is popular with school and post secondary students, private and professional researchers and local residents.

- providing appropriate access for researchers and visitors to collection items held
